## **Submission Guidelines:**

1. All submissions must be the student's own, original work. Only one entry per student.
2. **Entry deadline: 11:59 p.m., March 20, 2024.**
3. Essay must be typed and double-spaced in a Google Doc.
4. Essay must be between 400-600 words; this word count is for the body of the essay, not the title or name, date, grade, school, etc.
5. All quotations and copyrighted material used must be identified and cited properly. (MLA format)
6. At the top of the essay in the upper left corner, the student should include their first and last name, grade, school, parent/guardian name and email, and date.
7. The essay must include a title.
8. The essay should be emailed to [FHPSFoundationcontests@gmail.com](mailto:FHPSFoundationcontests@gmail.com).
9. Entries will be judged by a panel of individuals.
10. Winner will be announced online on the foundation's website, [www.fhpsf.org](http://www.fhpsf.org), by Monday, April 22, 2024.
